

#### Developing Innovative Programs and Services to Meet Local Needs:

- **ENCAP (Omaha):** Transportation Program for: OPS Students experiencing homelessness; job seekers or seniors 60+
- <u>CAPWN (Scottsbluff):</u> Health Center providing medical, dental and behavioral health clinic services
- <u>SENCA (Humboldt)</u>: Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) in house to provide advocacy for youth who have entered the child welfare system.
- <u>BVCA (Fairbury):</u> Professional development training program for childcare centers and their staff focused on improving quality of care
- CNCAP (Loup City): Currently developing a new program to address Veterans' Suicide Prevention
- <u>Mid (Kearney):</u> Reach Your Destination Early (RYDE) program serving 4 counties
- NENCAP (Pender): Tax Preparation Services through the VITA program
- <u>CAPLSC (Lincoln):</u> The Gathering Place, providing free home cooked nutritious foods to those in need daily
